GFA AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

- TYPE AFFECTED:** Speed Astir II and IIb, serial numbers 4001 up to 4107.
- SUBJECT:** Extension of service life.
- BACKGROUND:** The results of fatigue tests have shown that the service life of Glass and Carbon Fibre Reinforced Plastics gliders can be increased to a maximum of 12000 flight hours. (LBA AD No. 1998-480.)
- DOCUMENTATION:** Grob Service Bulletin No. 320-7.
- ACTION REQUIRED:** Inspection and exchange of pages in the flight and maintenance manuals in accordance with the Service Bulletin. The exchange of the manual pages must be performed before the next annual inspection.
- WEIGHT AND BALANCE:** Could be affected dependent on inspection and occurring repairs.
- IMPLEMENTATION:** The works must be carried out by an inspector rated for annual inspections (Form 2 inspector). Documentation is available from:
