SUBJECT: CRACKING OF PLY SKIN - ES 60 BOOMERANGS

- 1. Circular No 8/67 dated 14th June 1967 drew the attention of ES 60 owners to the fact that cracks had been found, extending from the rear inboard corner of the dive-brake cut-out to the end of the ply skin on the under surface of an ES 60 Boomerang. Subsequent inspection revealed two further cases.
- 2. Recently there have been two further cases, one of which occurred during aerobatics.
- 3. It is not considered that these cracks indicate a weakness in the primary wing structure of the ES 60 but should any evidence of such cracking be found, the fact should be reported to the CTO/A, C/o the above address, and to Mr. H. Schneider. Mr. Schneider will provide details of a modification to be incorporated during repairs.
- 4. All Boomerang Owners are to ensure that the Daily Inspection includes an examination of the ply skin in the region of the dive-brake cut-out on the underside of the wings.
