SUBJECT:

Inspection of the elevator root rib.

BACKGROUND:

The first issue of this AD was issued in 1972 and required the inspecting of elevator root rib for glue failure. Recently there was another failure of this rib and so it is now necessary to inspect this part every 3 years.

ACTION REQUIRED:

Before 1 August, 1994 or the next annual inspection 1. check the condition of the glue joint between the root rib and the leading edge ply and the elevator spar (see Figure 1). It will be necessary to remove the fabric covering to adequately inspect the joint. The inspection should be done using a feeler gauge or pen knife to check for glue separating.

If damage is found the rib must be removed completely, the faces cleaned and the rib glued back into position.

After inspection the fabric tape must be replaced to provide protection from moisture.

Every 3 years the inspection must be repeated in accordance with action 1.

Compliance with this AD must be recorded in the aircraft log book including the date for the next inspection.


