GLIDER TYPES AFFECTED: ASTIR CS from work No. 1001, ASTIR CS77 from work No.1601, and ASTIR CS JEANS from work No. 2001.

SUBJECT: For pilots of less than 70 kg with parachute trim weights are required. The installation allows for the carrying of trim weights for pilots from 55kg to 70 kg.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Installation of trim box left/right to drawing 102-7650/7651 by approved person carrying authorisation for approved modifications on the type.
- 2. Aircraft to be weighed with trim boxes fitted (minus weights) to establish new weight entry to weight sheet in the log book.
- 3. Application of placards to the trim boxes or next to the loading plan. Addition of exchange pages to the Flight and Service Manual.

WEIGHT AND BALANCE: See section 2 of instructions.

MATERIALS: One trim box left/right (102-7650/7651) complete with attachment material and six trim weights, placards and two pages for Manual. All materials and drawings listed will be available in complete kit form from LAMINAR PTY LTD. about March 1979. LAMINAR PTY LTD 6 Margitich Street Croydon Park S.A. 5008.

## COMPLIANCE:

The requirements of this AD are to be carried out not later than 30th of June 1979. The work performed is to be entered in the log book. This AD is mandatory and is issued pursuant to Air Navigation Regulations under the delegated authority of the Secretary of the Department of Transport.
