SUBJECT: Wear in the horizontal tailplane locating fork to be rectified and reduced in future service.

BACKGROUND: PZL bulletin No. BK-014/81 requests this modification to be carried out.

ACTION REQUIRED: (1) Inspection

Check the play between the fork and the "stone" in accordance with the Service Manual. If play exceeds the manual limits this modification is to be carried out before further flight.

If play is inside the limits, this modification may be left until the next Form 2 inspection.

MODIFICATION DETAILS:

- (1) Fig. 1. details the modification fully.
- (2) If factory supplied wear straps are not available, straps manfactured to Tig. 2 from 4130 Sheet steel, 1mm thick (approx) combined with AN 426 AD C'SK rivets 1/8" dia. will be acceptable, etch prime or similar is to be provided between the steel fitting and the alloy fork.
- (3) On completion the play should be within tolerance (max slop ,3mm) and the tailplane angle of incidence should be as specified in Service Manual.
- (4) Modification details to be entered into log book,

IMPLEMENTATION: This modification to be carried out by the holder of an 1109 endorsed metal repair/minor or C. of A. metal.

COMPLIANCE DATE.

- (1) Before next flight
- (a) Inspect for excessive play
- (b) Modify immediately if play exceeds limits.
- At next Form 2 inspection (a) Carry out this modification fully.

WEIGHT AND BALANCE: Negligible change.

The requirements of this Airworthiness Directive are mandatory, issued pursuant to Air Navigation Regulations under delegated authority from the Secretary of the Department of Transport Australia.




