TYPE AFFECTED:

Grob G109B powered sailplanes, all serial numbers

SUBJECT:

Additional cockpit placards and Flight Manual amendments required for Australian type acceptance.

ACTION:

At or before the initial C. of A. inspection

- 1. Add or exchange the following Flight Manual pages -
 - 7, 9, 25 and 26, dated Oct. 1st 1984 (AM 817-7)
 - 14, 17, 29, 30 and 58, Dated Jan 10th 1985 (TM 817-17)
 - Cover page, 1, 1a, 4, 8, 16, 18, 18b, 18c, 18e, 23, 27, 32 to 36, 38, 40, 45, 52 to 55, 60, 62 and 63. (Dated 11.3.88)
- 2. Provide Flight Manual stowage facility in the cockpit and placard it:-

Flight Manual Stowage

3. Fit the following placards in full view of both pilots -

No smoking

This powered sailplane is to be operated in accordance with ANO 95.4

4. Remove existing 'payload' and 'trim weight' placards from the cockpit and fit loading placards in accordance with instructions on page 54 of the Flight Manual.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- 1. Manual pages may be exchanged by the owner
- 2, 3, and 4. Cockpit placards and Flight Manual stowage facility to be fitted by a DoTC 1109 inspector, authorised for C. of A. inspection powered sailplane (any type) and the work entered in the sailplane's logbook.
