BACKGROUND: Overseas fatigue testing has shown that the service life of the LS 3 series may be increased to 6000 hours subject to special inspections at 3000,4000 and 5000 hours.

2. For the LS 3a and LS 3-17 update the Maintenance Manual by inserting page 5-2. All life extension inspections must be performed in accordance with the procedures set down on page 5-2 of the Maintenance Manual. This page is available from the GFA Secretariat on request.

IMPLEMENTATION: Updating of the Maintenance manual may be performed by the owner.
