## **GFA AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE**

TYPE AFFECTED:

L23 Super Blanik.

SUBJECT:

Periodic maintenance requirements.

BACKGROUND:

The factory maintenance requirements in addition to the annual GFA form 2 inspections and 20, 30 year surveys has resulted in a significant amount of extra work for L23 Super Blanik operators but experience with the Blanik L13 has shown that this has not resulted in any improvement to Blanik safety.

**DOCUMENTATION:** 

Report 82-10 Blanik 50 Hourly Inspections.

**ACTION REQUIRED:** 

- 1. The periodic maintenance requirements listed as Inspection 2, 3 and 4 on page 5-10-00 of the L23 Super Blanik Maintenance Manuals need not be completed as these items are covered by GFA Annual Inspections and 20, 30 etc. year surveys.
- 2. Every 100 hours  $\pm$  10 hours the following inspections must be performed rather than the procedures listed under Periodic Maintenance Inspection 1 on page 5-10-00 of the L 23 Super Blanik Maintenance Manual. Note that at each annual inspection the procedures listed as Inspection 1 must be completed in addition to a normal GFA Annual Inspection.
- a) Carry out a Daily Inspection.
- b) Measure the freeplay of all control surfaces.
- c) Check the tailplane for excessive tip movement.
- d) Check the rudder cables for wear and fatigue especially at all pulleys and at the rudder horn. Check that the pulleys turn freely and if necessary lubricate.
- e) Clean out under the floor. Ensure the entire aircraft is clean.
- f) Check the Oleo leg for correct pressure and any leaks.
- g) Lubricate the undercarriage.

- h) Carry out any airworthiness directives which are based on 50 hourly recurring intervals.
- i) Perform any other maintenance which experience has shown to be necessary under local conditions.

WEIGHT AND BALANCE: Not affected.

**IMPLEMENTATION:** 

100 Hourly inspections may be completed by persons rated "Replacement of Components - Metal" except that if work beyond the normal functions of a Component Replacement Inspector is required that work must be checked by persons rated as "Annual Inspectors - Metal".

\_COMPLIANCE:

The requirements of this GFA Airworthiness Directive are mandatory. This Directive is issued pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Gliding Federation of Australia.
